## **Established Practices**

- Advance / SCRCS has established the ASRE Pathway as a tool to communicate requirements for an UR experience and to tack and assess the experience.
- 2. The University of Louisiana at Lafayette has an *established definition* of a Student Research Experience (SRE).
- 3. UL Lafayette has set criteria for an effective CURE = a course-embedded SRE.
- 4. Advance has partnered with established University groups to maximize the use of existing resource.
- Advance / SCRCS has established a set of annual events that service & reward faculty, staff, and students.

- Grow membership from across Louisiana's Colleges and Universities.




- All courses that are ASRE Pathway approved have an attribute in the academic catalog, ASRE
- Some freshmen students have made the mistake that and "Advance" course means it is academically advanced. UNIV is the place to let student know what the Advance Student Research Program is. Without this explanation the verbiage is very confusing.
- Students must be in the correct catalog to participate in the program. (in most but not all cases)

#### **Established Practices**

#### UL Lafayette has set criteria for an effective CURE = a course-embedded SRE

- ✓ The SRE is embedded into the course curriculum
- ✓ All students in the class engage in the SRE in some fashion
- ✓ Outcomes of the SRE are *unknown* beforehand
- ✓ Students work collaboratively as much as possible
- ✓ SRE projects introduce students to the professional research methodologies of the discipline
- ✓ Outcomes of the SRE are communicated to a stakeholder that is not the course instructor of record

## Exploring modes of dissemination in student scholarship

- Written Paper
- Oral Presentations
- Poster Presentations
- Instagram or Tic Toc videos (social media)
- Blog or webpage
- Media coverage (radio or film)
- Zine (Comics with academic content; self-made, reproducible)
