Creative Activity Guidelines

Presenters should prepare for **10 minutes in length**. Each presenter will have 15 minutes of time provided to them.

Presenters will have 2.5 minutes to stage and another 2.5 minutes to exit.

Within your Creative Activity presentation, be sure to include an explanation of your project/performance and the creative process of your work.

A projector and screen will be available for videos, pictures, and/or to play audio. Be sure to bring a **USB flash drive** with your project saved on it. We will have a laptop connected to the projector. **Do not rely on the cloud or internet to present your project.**

You can bring musical instruments to perform, however, there will **not** be any sound equipment (e.g. amplifiers, microphones) available.

Physical art: You can bring physical art to present and explain. However, we suggest bringing digital pictures and/or videos of your physical art to avoid possible damage. The projector and screen can be utilized for your display.
