5. Three (3) approved workshop or training

- Approved workshops or trainings can include, but are not limited to: SCRCs, library, or university workshops. SCRCs Advance Workshops can be found on the UL Lafayette SCRCs website. 1 in person SCRCs workshop is equivalent to 2 virtual SCRCs workshops, thus, 2 virtual workshops would be needed to count for 1 workshop/training experience. Other workshops/trainings focused on research skills are possible by approval from the School of Geosciences.

6. Professional Development

Leadership Experience

- Leadership experience includes but is not limited to departmental service events, officership in departmental club, SGA member, or assisting in hosting an event or conference.

Mentored Research

- Mentored Research includes, but is not limited to, volunteer, scholarship, paid from grants or SUREs (Summer Undergraduate Research Experience).

OR

Internship/Work Experience

- Internship/Work Experience may be internal or external to UL Lafayette. ENVS 472 can count if not used as a curricular requirement.
