

Pathway of Distinction

Curricular

ASRE-approved courses only. Students who have earned credits for a course that is not ASRE approved may petition to substitute that course with a course 300 or 400 level course identified as providing research skill. The SCRCS Advance office will review the petition for approval.

Approved substitutions are only for the purpose of completing an Advance Pathway and are not approved as substitution for the degree.

1. UNIV 100
2. HIST 390
3. Two HIST 300 level courses
 - Choose from HIST 327, HIST 355, HIST 367, HIST 369, HIST 371, HIST 378, HIST 384, or HIST 395.
4. One HIST 400 level course
 - Choose from HIST 420, HIST 430, HIST 451, HIST 452, or HIST 471.
5. HIST 490

Co-curricular

6. Two (2) approved workshops
 - Approved workshops can include, but are not limited to SCRCS, library, or university workshops. SCRCS Advance Workshops can be found on the UL Lafayette SCRCS website. 1 in person SCRCS workshop is equivalent to 2 virtual SCRCS workshops. Other workshops focused on research skills are possible by approval from the History department.

7. Dissemination

Advance Undergraduate Research Showcase

OR

Present at UL Undergraduate Research Conference.

Pathway of Excellence

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7. Approved training
 - Complete UL IRB's "Undergraduate Training on Human Subjects Research" through Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI). Other training can be reviewed and approved by department.

8. Professional Development

Involvement in university or professional organization

- Can include, but is not limited to, regular attendance at meetings or service as an officer of an approved organization.

OR

Study Abroad

- Study abroad courses include, but are not limited to, HIST 371, HIST 420, HIST 430, HIST 440, or HIST 451

9. Dissemination

Presentation at a state, regional, national, or international professional conference.

- Only state, regional, national, or international conference will count. (Examples include, but are not limited to: Louisiana Historical Association, Southwestern Social Sciences Association, Phi Alpha Theta History Honor Society Regional or National Conferences)

OR

Honors Thesis

OR

Publication submission (author or co-author)

Must be peer-reviewed outlet, for example: *Clio's Quill*
