Curricular

ASRE-approved courses only. Students who have earned credits for a course that is not ASRE approved may petition to substitute that course with a course PSYC 300 or 400 level course identified by the department. The SCRCs Advance office will review the petition for approval. Approved substitutions are only for the purpose of completing an Advance Pathway and are not approved as substitution for the degree.

Co-curricular

7. Three (3) research-related training or workshops

- Approved workshops can include, but are not limited to SCRCs, library, or university workshops. SCRCs Advance Workshops can be found on the UL Lafayette SCRCs website. 1 in person SCRCs workshop is equivalent to 2 virtual SCRCs workshops, thus, 2 virtual workshops would be needed to count for 1 workshop/training experience. Other workshops focused on research skills are possible by approval from the Psychology Department. Other trainings that could count include CITI training or others as specified by the Psychology Department.

8. Mentored research

- Active involvement in a research lab or independent research project supervised by a Psychology faculty member or other approved UL faculty member, for at least one semester. Mentored research includes, but is not limited to, volunteer, scholarship, or paid from grants. Mentored research may also be internal to UL Lafayette or external to UL Lafayette. The Psychology Department will evaluate the mentored research based on the research submitted by the student and input from their mentor.

9. Presentation at a departmental, university, regional, national, or international conference.

- Must be oral or poster presentation.

8. Four (4) research-related training or workshops
 - Approved workshops can include, but are not limited to SCRCs, library, or university workshops. SCRCs Advance Workshops can be found on the UL Lafayette SCRCs website. 1 in person SCRCs workshop is equivalent to 2 virtual SCRCs workshops, thus, 2 virtual workshops would be needed to count for 1 workshop/training experience. Other workshops focused on research skills are possible by approval from the Psychology Department. Other trainings that could count include CITI training or others as specified by the Psychology Department.
9. Mentored research
 - Active involvement in a research lab or independent research project supervised by a Psychology faculty member or other approved UL faculty member, for at least one semester. Mentored research includes, but is not limited to, volunteer, scholarship, or paid from grants. Mentored research may also be internal to UL Lafayette or external to UL Lafayette. The Psychology Department will evaluate the mentored research based on the research submitted by the student and input from their mentor.
10. Presentation at a departmental, university, regional, national, or international conference.
 - Must be oral or poster presentation.

11. Dissemination

Presentation at regional, national, or international conference

- Must be oral or poster presentation. Only regional, national, or international conferences will receive credit. Must also be a different conference than Presentation from requirement #9.

OR

Honors Thesis

OR

Manuscript submission (co-author)

- Student must co-author with a faculty member.
