7. Mentored research
 - Active involvement in a research lab or research project supervised by a CODI faculty member (research or clinical), for at least one semester. Mentored research includes, but is not limited to, volunteer, scholarship, grants, summer research projects (LLP, STAR, etc.), study abroad courses, or enhanced course assignments. Mentored research may also be internal to UL Lafayette or external to UL Lafayette. Opportunities external to UL Lafayette must be approved by CODI mentor.
8. Presentation at a departmental, university, regional, national, or international conference
 - Must be oral or poster presentation.

7. Three (3) research-related approved trainings or workshops

8. Mentored research

- Active involvement in a research lab or research project supervised by a CODI faculty member (research or clinical), for at least one semester. Mentored research may also be internal to UL Lafayette or external to UL Lafayette. Opportunities external to UL Lafayette must be approved by CODI mentor.

9. Presentation at a departmental, university, regional, national, or international conference

- Must be oral or poster presentation.

10. Dissemination

Presentation at a state, regional, national, or international conference

- Must be oral or poster presentation. Can be the same presentation as Presentation4 requirement but must be presented at state, regional, national, or international conference.

OR

Manuscript submission (co-author)

- Student must co-author with CODI faculty.

OR

Participate in grant submission for intramural or extramural grant

- Student must participate in the development of the grant (either written portion, idea formulation, or literature review).

OR

Honors thesis
